POWERS DELEGATED TO DEPUTY CHIEF ENGINEER, ALL INDIA RADIO

1	Technical sanction to detailed estimates.	Power to accord technical sanction to the detailed estimates upto a limit of Rs. 2,00,000 for works to be executed departmentally after they have been administratively approved by the competent authority. This limit is exclusive of charges for establishment of Tools and Plant.	Min. of I&B letter No. 13 (2)D5/63-D(B&A), dated 24-6-67.
2	Technical sanction to revised estimates.	Power to accord technical sanction to revised estimates upto a limit of Rs. 2,00,000 and to pass excess over estimate provided that the excess is not more than 5% of the amount sanctioned and does not exceed the amount upto which the officer is empowered to accord sanction to an original estimate. He will not pass any excess over a revised estimate sanctioned by a higher authority than himself. He may pass excesses over estimates provided that the excess is not more than 5% of the amount sanctioned and that all such cases where the excess so sanctioned makes the total estimates exceed the amount upto which he is empowered to accord technical sanction, should be reported every month to his next higher authority which has to satisfy itself about the propriety of the excess sanctioned.	-do-
3	Sanction to revise technical estimates on the basis of completion reports.	Power to accord sanction to revise technical estimates on the basis of completion reports upto the limit of his power for sanctioning revised technical estimates.	Min. of I&B letter No. 13(2) D5/63-D(B&A), dated 24-6-67.

4	Power to revise estimates when substantial savings are expected.	Power to revise estimates upto a limit of Rs. 2,00,000 when substantial savings (more than 5% original technical sanction) are expected due to abandonment of the substantial section of a project or due to material deviations from the original proposals. The exercise of this power is subject to the provisions of the notes below paras 79 and 80 of CPWD Code. The reduced amount of expenditure sanction will be intimated to Audit also. 5	Power to sanction separate detailed estimates for components or small parts of a project.	Power to sanction, within, the powers of technical sanction, viz. upto a limit of Rs. 2,00,000 separate detailed estimates for components or small parts of the projects for which expenditure sanction of the competent authority has been accorded. The exercise of this power is subject to the conditions stipulated in para 81 of CPWD Code read with para 73 as revised.	-do-
6	Diversion of savings from one section of a Project to another, etc.	Power for diversion of savings from (a) one section of a project to another and (b) from contingencies to any item of work or repair not covered by the original detailed estimates, sanctioned by him. The exercise of this power is subject to the restrictions imposed in paras 89 and 90 of CPWD Code and also Notes 1 & 2 below para 91.	Ministry of I&B letter No. 13(2)D5/63-D(B&A), dated 24-6-67.
7	Procurement of stores for reserve stock.	Power to approve the estimate for the purchase of materials for reserve stock within the sanctioned Reserve Stock limit.	-do-

The exercise of this power is subject to (i) stipulations mentioned in para 142 of the CPWD Code in regard to the rules for the supply of articles, (ii) provisions of para 145 of CPWD Code and Powers specifically delegated to departmental officers for purchase of stores borne and not borne on DGS & D rate running contract.

8 • Power to issue orders for disposal of stores declared by competent authority to be surplus or unserviceable.

9 Write off from returns of tools and plants which part value has been recovered upto a limit of Rs. 10,000.
